Providing clubs with effective ongoing support is a fundamental principle of this strategy.

We will provide inclusive engagement opportunities by promoting our wide range of clubs, products, services and events, tackling inequality by ensuring that we offer something for everyone.

Potential



Develop and support our clubs and coaches

OUR AMBITIONS:

To ensure our clubs and coaches feel valued and respected, creating true ambassadors for our organisation who will go on to inspire the next generation of volunteers to take Taekwondo forward.

To achieve this we will:

- Put in place on-going club and coach recognition programmes and deliver exceptional end-of-year celebrations, rewarding longevity of service, growth, and competence.
- Conduct regular membership surveys, ensuring that initiatives are warmly received and relevant, and if they are not, use data, insight and learning to review and revise.

To provide opportunities to all clubs and coaches to access education and support of the highest quality.

To achieve this we will:

- Develop and deliver gold standard Club Coach, Tutor and Examiner Education Programmes, increasing the number and quality nationwide across all disciplines.
- Ensure the sustainable growth of our essential club infrastructure which serves our core market of regular practitioners.

To achieve this we will:

Research, develop and deliver club support tools and services, including a Club Development Portal, helping to create and protect the places which enable people to be active through Taekwondo.





Provide development pathways for our members

OUR AMBITIONS:

To support the development of our participants by providing clear pathway programmes which guide an individual's development at every step of their Taekwondo journey.

To achieve this we will:

- Establish national pathway models which all clubs and coaches will be encouraged to adopt to support the progression of athletes from Beginner to Elite level across all disciplines.
- Ensure that retiring participants are encouraged to remain within the Taekwondo family as officials, club coaches, volunteers, or event organisers.
- To support the development of our officials by providing clear pathways for progression.

To achieve this we will:

Develop and deliver gold standard Officials Education Programmes, increasing the number of qualified and active officials at all levels across the UK.

To devise and support the delivery of a comprehensive, diverse, and wide-reaching calendar of high-quality domestic competitions and events, to provide the platforms for growth and success for participants at every level.

- Develop innovative entry level events which are accessible, safe, and fun!
- Develop local and regional competition and events structures for each discipline, encouraging a level playing field and providing event organisers with tool kits and resources to make staging events safe, simple and cost effective.
- Ensure that the format for the British Championships results in well-attended, high profile events which support talent identification and inspire participation.

OUR OBJECTIVE

Retain and increase participation

OUR AMBITIONS:

To deliver outstanding levels of customer service.

To achieve this we will:

- Engage regularly with our clubs and members, ensuring continued improvement in customer satisfaction, support, and incentives.
- To support our coaches to provide high quality, accessible and diverse experiences which connect activity, health and mental wellbeing.

To achieve this we will:

- Ensure that we consistently listen to and serve the needs of our diverse membership.
- Develop and launch tailored 'off-the-shelf' products for different audiences, for example, under-7s, general fitness, female-specific, older, and disabled participant-focused programmes, so more people can feel the benefits of an active life.

To retain and increase the number of people participating in Taekwondo in club, education, and community settings.

To achieve this we will:

- Develop and support coaches to deliver comprehensive community-based and disability engagement programmes.
- Develop a pathway programme for schools as part of a range of activities providing positive experiences for children and young people.
- Devise and deliver an engagement plan for university clubs, building relationships with BUCS and the British Students Taekwondo Federation.
- To increase our membership to 50,000 by 2031, reinvesting revenues to benefit all clubs and members.

- Develop and launch a tiered membership structure providing different membership packages tailored to different audiences.
- Put in place fantastic member and club affiliation benefits, ensuring that these are well communicated.





Operate to the highest standard of governance

OUR AMBITIONS:

To develop and maintain best practice and transparent governance, with clear financial and operational policies and procedures.

To achieve this we will:

- Provide effective leadership and operate with complete transparency, accountability and integrity.
- Set up and maintain best practice policies and procedures across all areas including Equality and Diversity, Data Protection and Health & Safety.
- Transform the delivery of our services, protecting the welfare of all those involved in Taekwondo, reflecting our core values throughout everything that we do.

To achieve this we will:

- Appoint a suitably trained team of Club Welfare Officers, ensuring that standard operating procedures are followed to safeguard all participants and coaches.
- Ensure that any safeguarding or child protection cases are dealt with effectively and within an agreed timeframe.

To be an organisation that people want to work for and with.

To achieve this we will:

- Cultivate a positive working environment across all Taekwondo settings, which provide opportunities for development, progression, and new experiences.
- To develop and maintain strong and transparent relationships with our stakeholders, supporting each other to reach our organisational objectives.

- Form direct relationships, where appropriate, with national and local grass root and community organisations.
- Continue to deepen our close relationship with GB Taekwondo, the city of Manchester, and other key partners.

Innovate and grow our organisation

OUR AMBITIONS:

To be the 'go-to' organisation for Taekwondo, increasing the visibility of our clubs, products, services and events through innovative digital engagement strategies.

To achieve this we will:

- Invest in technology to develop systems which help us to operate more effectively.
- Develop and implement a marketing and communications strategy which secures positive engagement with new and existing audiences.
- Host domestic and international major events in all disciplines, using these events as the shop window to our sport and Martial Art.
- To take Taekwondo to the mass market, ensuring that we remain relevant and aspirational.

To achieve this we will:

- Develop strategies and incentives to improve the geographical reach of our club network, helping to connect communities through sport and physical activity.
- Provide support to every club to increase their visibility.
- Capture data through various forms of research, ensuring that organisational decisions are evidence and feedback-based.

To generate increased revenues, growing our organisation sustainably, and enabling re-investment into Taekwondo for the benefit of our clubs, coaches, and members.

- Secure long-term commercial partners, generating direct revenue and providing products and services which benefit and support our clubs and members.
- Generate member-based revenue through diversifying our offer; merchandise, tiered membership packages, club promotion products, teaching aids and hosting events.
- Secure significant investment from the relevant public sector funding bodies by performing well against our common strategic ambitions.

To support the delivery of podium results on the world stage through effective performance pathway strategies which identify and develop athlete potential in all disciplines.

To achieve this we will:

- Establish optimal talent identification and selection policies.
- Support selected athletes to travel to international events.
- Upskill talented and motivated club coaches across all disciplines to performance level methodology.
- Collaborate with GB Taekwondo, supporting their ambition for even greater Olympic and Paralympic success.

To achieve this we will:

- Deepen collaboration with GB
 Taekwondo to ensure that our talented coaches have access to and engage in Elite Coach Education programmes for Sport and Para-Sport and align to GB Taekwondo's practices.
- Deliver against an international events strategy which maximises performance impacts and creates a diverse talent pool for the future.

To be an outstanding Member National Association for World Taekwondo, hosting major international events, developing international standard coaches and officials, proactively championing the progression of Taekwondo internationally.

- Support talented British Taekwondo coaches, Martial Art instructors, referees, officials, and classifiers to secure World Taekwondo and Kukkiwon international qualifications, by defining clear pathways and selection processes.
- Provide those selected individuals with logistical and financial support to attend international events where possible.
- Secure positions of leadership at World Taekwondo and World Taekwondo Europe Council and Committee level and build stronger relationships with Kukkiwon.

Outcomes




